Releases

- First album, *Lifeline* (2018), was composed in honor of Suzanne's late brother, Raymond.
- Second album, *Horizons*, later in 2018, was composed as a reminder of the wonderment through each experience and stage in our lives.
- Also released in 2018, *Cheerful Explorations* is Suzanne's suite of educational pieces for a life-long appreciation of music in aspiring, young piano students.
- Released *Cascades of Time* in 2019 as a collection of innovative, enchanting solo piano stylings evoking passing years, fleeting moments, and continuation of time through both joy and tribulation.



- Fifth album, *Stories from Portugal* (2021), inspired while Suzanne was travelling throughout Portugal and experiencing the country's rich traditions, welcoming people, and natural beauty, which served as a reminder that wherever we venture in this world becomes part of our personal story.
- *Path of the Sandpiper*, (2022 single release and nominated Best 2022 Solo Piano Single by One World Music Radio), describes one of Florida's beautiful beach birds, sandpipers, gently scurrying together along the water's edge.
- *Dancing Lights* (single, 2022), was inspired by the shimmering patterns of lights on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge, that make the water sparkle, on the west coast of Florida.
- *Sailing to a Sunset* (single, 2023), transports the listener to the changing textures of the sky while experiencing the setting sun.
- Most recent album, *A Seaside View*, musically describes Suzanne's favorite local beach on the west coast of Florida, Anna Maria Island. Incredibly natural and pristine, this spectacular panorama of shoreline vistas, coastal wildlife, and changing moods is expressed in the music of *A Seaside View*.
